ANNUAL FISH FRY MOVED TO "CARRY-OUT ONLY"

Every August, for 10+ years, Calvary has hosted an All-You-Can-Eat Fish & Chicken fry featuring the delicious frying of Dan's Fish Fry (Huntington). Not only do we see over 500 people from the Wells County community come through our doors, but 100% of the proceeds go directly to Family Centered Services, whose mission is to strengthen the community by empowering families and youth through services that educate and inspire.

Traditionally, Calvary's annual fish fry has been all-you-caneat for dine in customers, with a carry-out drive-thru option. We typically have a good size crowd, and are able to squeeze a lot of people into the space we have here at Calvary. Due to the continued circumstances we find ourselves in regarding the coronavirus, Calvary's council members have voted to follow the guidance of Dan's Fish Fry and move this year's fish fry to "CARRY-OUT ONLY."

While things will look different, we are still confident that God can and will work through Calvary to be the heart, hands, and feet of Jesus in this community through this event. Volunteers will still play a huge role in making this event a success. NEW WORSHIP SERIES

What happens when our world falls apart? How do we press onward when our tightly-knit plans unravel into loose threads? What do we become when our identity—or the path we're on—comes undone? What if all of this is not the end we fear it will be? In our unraveling, sometimes life surprises us with unexpected joy, love, and hope—with a new beginning we couldn't have imagined. Sometimes we need God to unravel us, for we long to be changed. This worship series explores 12 stories of unraveled shame, identity, fear, grief, dreams, and expectations. These are stories where God meets us in

the spiraling, unraveling our plans—and us—into something new.

Over the course of this 12 week series, the Unraveled theme will permeate every aspect of worship (liturgy, pravers, music, etc.). Congregants will also be encouraged to utilize the Unvraveled Study Journal. Each journal includes: original visual art inspired by the text, an artist statement reflecting on how the scripture inspired the art, prompts for visual meditation to engage the art, prompts for individual or group reflection on the scripture, a prompt for journaling in response to the scripture, and a short closing prayer.


